## **VARSITY TRACK 1977:**



## FACTS ABOUT EASTERN:

ECSC is a small, progressive College with an expanding campus and increasing enrollments (2,000 full-time day students) in all its divisions. Founded in 1889, the campus is lacated in the heart of Eastern Connecticut, an area noted for its beautiful lakes and streams, rolling hills, and clean air. Eastern is 25 miles from Hartford and 80 miles from Boston. The Connecticut shoreline lies 30 miles to the south.
