Varsity Track 1977:

JOHN KELEHER is in charge of "running" at Eastern, heading both the Track and Cross-Country Teams. Last year's second year Track team, 8-12, made a fine showing with consistent improvement in evidence. John notes: "a very good effort was made at one point or another, by just about everyone... a very positive season". The Track Team participated in the New England Regionals and the NCAA Div. III Championships in Chicago. Coach Keleher is a graduate of the University of Connecticut where he was an outstanding cross-country and Distance Runner. He has been with ECSC for 7 years.

Assessing this year's squad, Keleher says "For the first time, we'll be really competitive with everyone on our schedule. Along with Vin Pillari (Norwich senior) who I consider to be one of the best shot putters in the Nation, we have Joe Noel of Rockville, running the mile and 3-mile for us; Tim Costello of East Hartford in the Long Jump; and Richard Wells of Columbia in the Sprints. I'm really looking forward to the season; it's going to be good competition, and that means a lot of fun as well."

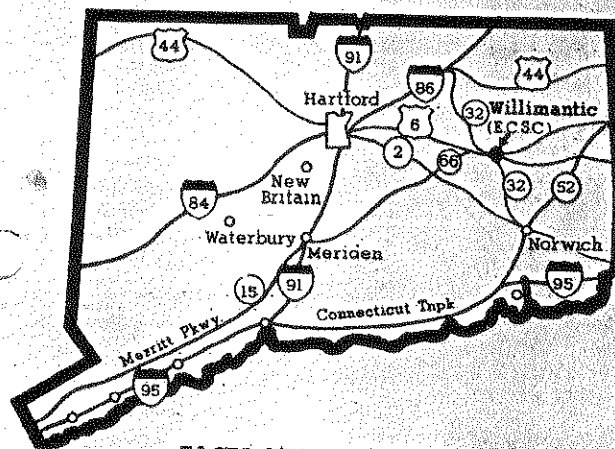

FACTS ABOUT EASTERN:

ECSC is a small, progressive College with an expanding campus and increasing enrollments (2,000 full-time day students) in all its divisions. Founded in 1889, the campus is located in the heart of Eastern Connecticut, an area noted for its beautiful lakes and streams, rolling hills, and clean air. Eastern is 25 miles from Hartford and 80 miles from Boston. The Connecticut shoreline lies 30 miles to the south.
