TRIO LEADS EASTERN M-CROSS COUNTRY AT NEW ENGLAND MEET

Curley, Tignonsini and Buczek top Warriors, who place 36th at regional qualifier

SPRINGFIELD, Mass. – **Michael Curley (Jr./Branford)**, **David Tignonsini (Fr./Vernon)** and **Sam Buczek (Fr./Milford)** crossed the finish line within a span of seven seconds as the Eastern Connecticut State University men's cross country team placed 36th in a field of 45 scoring teams at the 2006 NCAA Division III New England Regional Qualifier, run over 8,000 meters Saturday at Veterans Memorial Golf Course.

For the first time in this meet, Curley (30:06) paced Eastern at the finish and was followed by first-year teammates Tignonsini (30:11) and Buczek (30:13). It was the fourth time in seven races this year that Curley led his teammates at the finish line.

Curley scored in 187th place, Tignonsini 191st and Buczek 194th among 298 individuals who scored points. Hunter Norte of Trinity, 21st in this meet a year ago, was the individual winner, while Williams College put three runners among the top seven in breezing to a 68-point win over Bowdoin College to capture the team title.

Curley, **Jim Condren (So./Southington)**, **Zak Taylor (Jr./Hampton)** **Nicholas Noheimer (So./Willimantic)** all returned to compete in this race on this course from a year ago. Condren (31:09) was Eastern's fourth finisher, with Taylor (31:22) fifth and Noheimer (32:16) sixth. Condren scored in 223rd place, Taylor in 224th place and Noheimer at 241st.

Little East Conference champion University of Southern led all conference schools with a tenth-place finish while New England Alliance champion Keene State College followed in 15th place.

Marshall closes out four-year career by cutting 14 seconds off her 2005 time at meet

SPRINGFIELD, Mass. – In the final race of her four-year career, **Jessie Marshall (Sr./Yantic)** chopped 14 seconds off her time and moved up 16 scoring places from a year ago on this course in leading the Eastern Connecticut State University women's cross country team at the 2006 NCAA Division III New England Regional Qualifier, run over 6,000 meters Saturday at Veterans Memorial Golf Course.

As a team, Eastern placed 39th among 48 teams which scored points. Ellen Davis of Wesleyan, seventh a year ago, won the individual title while Middlebury College edged Amherst College by five points – both teams placed two runners among the Top Ten – to claim the team title.

Marshall, who completed her career by participating in each of the team's 26 meets, led Eastern for the seventh straight time this year with a scoring finish of 182nd among 308 individual scorers. She was timed in 27:00. As a junior, Marshall scored in the 198th spot among 281 scorers in a time of 27:14.

Competing in her final career race, **Amy Zawistowski (Sr./Manchester)** followed Marshall at the finish, taking 226th overall in a time of 28:29. **Terry Frechette (So./Ledyard)**, second to Marshall at this meet last year, followed right behind Zawistowski, placing 228th in a time of 28:31. Rounding out Eastern's finishers were **Clara Juncadella (So./Guilford)**, **Jennifer Cody (Jr./East Lyme)** and **Ashley Behrent (Sr./Colchester)**. Juncadella (28:42) was 233rd, Cody (28:57) 238th and Behrent (30:50), in her final career race, 273rd.

As a sophomore at the New England meet, Marshall placed 223rd in a field of 268 in a time of 28:18 as the Warriors' third finisher at Twin Brook Recreation Center in Cumberland, ME. As a freshman at Cumberland, she was 208th of 252 runners overall in a time of 28:45 as Eastern's No. 6 runner.

DEPTH CARRIES EASTERN MEN'S XC PAST RHODE ISLAND

Warriors runners capture 5-through-8 positions in 28-31 victory over Anchormen

MANSFIELD, Conn. – Nicholas Noheimer (So./Willimantic), David Tignonsini (Fr./Vernon), Zak Taylor (Jr./Hampton) and Jim Condren (So./Southington) all crossed the finish line ahead of Rhode Island College's No. 4 finisher to propel the Eastern Connecticut State University men's cross country team to a slim 28-31 victory Saturday morning at Mansfield Hollow State Park.

Led by senior individual winner Eric Lonergan, Rhode Island (0-1) captured three of the first four spots, but Noheimer, Tignonsini, Taylor and Condren filled in to round out Eastern's (1-1) scoring, and Sam Buczek (Fr./Milford) and Sean McLaughlin (So./Branford) ate up the next two spots to push Rhode Island's No. 4 runner – junior Greg Clark – back to 11th place and pave the way to the three-point victory.

Michael Curley (Jr./Branford) was Eastern's first finisher for the third time in five races, finishing second overall to Lonergan by 47 seconds. Lonergan, who was fifth overall in last year's Little East Conference Championship, paced a field of 16 runners in a time of 29:16. Curley missed breaking 30 minutes by four seconds.

EASTERN'S MARSHALL RUNS TO FIRST CAREER XC WIN

Competing in her 25th straight race, senior leads Warriors past Rhode Island

MANSFIELD, Conn. – Fourth-year letterwinner **Jessie Marshall (Sr./Yantic)** posted her first individual victory in her 25th career race, leading 11 runners at the finish line when the Eastern Connecticut State University women's cross country team downed Rhode Island College Saturday morning at Mansfield Hollow State Park.

The team's top runner in all five meets this year, Marshall won by 50 seconds in a time of 21:40. Eastern (1-1) runners took the top three spots and placed their five scoring performers in the top six positions for a 17-38 win over the Anchorwomen (0-1).

In the team's home-opening meet a month ago, Marshall had run to a second-place finish in a field of 12 in the team's nine-point loss to Bridgewater State College.

Terry Frechette (So./Ledyard) and **Amy Zawistowski (Sr./Manchester)** followed just under a minute behind Marshall, with **Clara Juncadella (So./Guilford)** fifth overall. **Jennifer Cody (Jr./East Lyme)** rounded out the team's scorers.

EASTERN M-CROSS COUNTRY THIRD AT RAY DWYER INVITE

Led by John Loffredo, three of team's top five finishers are freshmen

WARWICK, R.I. -- First-year runners **John Loffredo (Fr./East Hampton)**, **David Tignonsini (Fr./Vernon)** and **Sam Buczek (Fr./Milford)** finished among the team's five scorers and helped the Eastern Connecticut State University men's cross country team to third place at the Ray Dwyer Invitational Saturday at Goddard Memorial State Park.

After becoming the first freshman to lead the Warriors in a race in six years last Saturday, Loffredo (32:52) repeated his first-place finish Saturday, taking 12th place among 75 finishers. He was third overall among all freshmen in the race, which was run over 8,000 meters.

The U.S. Coast Guard Academy breezed to a 19-point win over Division I Bryant University. Eastern (100 points) edged Johnson & Wales (108) for third in the six-team field. Coast Guard runners captured three of the top five places, but Eric Lonergan, a senior from Little East Conference institution and host Rhode Island College, won the individual title in a time of 30:38.

Michael Curley (Sr./Branford) followed Loffredo by just under a minute, placing 20th overall in a time of 33:43. Tignonsini moved up a spot to finish third among Eastern runners, 30th overall in a time of 34:23. **Nicholas Noheimer (So./Willimantic)** was six seconds behind Tignonsini, 32nd overall in a time of 34:29. Buczek rounded out Eastern's scorers, placing 39th overall in a time of 34:59.

Marshall is team's first runner across the line at Ray Dwyer Invitational

WARWICK, R.I. -- **Jessie Marshall (Sr./Yantic)** led the Eastern Connecticut State University women's cross country team at the finish line for the third time in as many meets this year as the Warriors placed sixth in a seven-team field at the Ray Dwyer Invitational Saturday at Goddard Memorial State Park.

Marshall, the team's only fourth-year competitor, finished 20th overall in a time of 20:59 as the team's top scorer in the field of 76 over the 5,000 meter layout. It was the 23rd consecutive race of her career.

The U.S. Coast Guard Academy locked up five of the top six spots in coasting to a 32-point win over Wellesley College. Eastern totaled 161 points, outdistancing last-place Rhode Island College (206).

Eastern's other scorers were **Ashley Behrent (Sr./Colchester)**, **Amy Zawistowki (Sr./Manchester)**, **Terry Frechette (So./Ledyard)**, and **Clara Juncadella (So./Guilford)**. Behrent was 47th overall in a time of 22:22; Zawistowski 54th in a time of 22:46; Frechette 61st in a time of 23:26 and Juncadella 63rd in a time of 23:40.

LOFFREDO PACES EASTERN M-CROSS COUNTRY AT UMD

Becomes first freshman to lead Warriors at the finish line in six seasons

NORTH DARTMOUTH, Mass. – **John Loffredo (Fr./East Hampton)** became the first freshman to lead all Eastern Connecticut State University runners at the finish line in six years as the Warriors placed 20th in a field of 29 Saturday at the 34th Annual University of Massachusetts Dartmouth Cross Country Invitational.

Competing in his second collegiate race, Loffredo (28:23) placed 94th overall in a field of 196 finishers over the five mile layout. Three of Eastern's top four finishers were freshmen, with all three breaking 30 minutes.

Trinity College runners took four of the top 14 spots on the way to a nine-point win over Brandeis University.

In all, four Eastern runners broke the 30 minute barrier. **Michael Curley (Jr./Branford)**, who finished first among Eastern runners for the first time in his career last Saturday in a season-opening dual meet against Bridgewater State College, followed Loffredo in a time of 29:00. **Sam Buczek (Fr./Milford)** was timed in 29:37 in his first collegiate race. Curley was 115th overall, Buczek 124th.

David Tignonsini (Fr./Vernon), the team's third freshman, was 132nd overall in a time of 29:54. **Nicholas Noheimer (So./Willimantic)**, was Eastern's final scorer. He placed 145th overall in a time of 30:31.

Other Eastern runners completing the varsity race were **Mark Lewis (Sr./Windsor)**, **Sean McLaughlin (So./Branford)** and **Jim Condren (So./Southington)**. Lewis (30:34) was 148th, McLaughlin (31:18) 155th and Condren (31:46) 160th.

Prior to the race, the last Eastern freshman to lead the team in a race was Kristopher Sortwell at the New England Division III Championship in 2000.

MARSHALL FINISHES IN TOP HALF OF UMD W XC FIELD

Running in her 22nd consecutive race, Eastern runner is 113th out of 229

NORTH DARTMOUTH, Mass. – **Jessie Marshall (Sr./Yantic)** led seven Eastern Connecticut State University women's runners across the finish line as the Warriors placed 25th in a field of 33 Saturday at the 34th Annual University of Massachusetts Dartmouth Cross Country Invitational.

Competing in the 22nd consecutive race in her four-year career, Marshall (22:13) came in 113th overall, finishing in the top half of the 229-person field. Amherst College put all five of its scoring runners among the top 12 in easing to a 33-point win over Colby College.

Marshall led all Eastern runners for the second time in her career, the first time coming last Saturday in a home dual meet against Bridgewater State College. **Ashley Behrent (Sr./Colchester)** was Eastern's second runner, placing 143rd in a time of 23:06 over the 5,000 meter course. Also scoring points for Eastern were **Clara Juncadella (So./Guilford)**, **Amy Zawistowski (Manchester)**, and **Katie La Marr (Sol/Cromwell)**. Juncadella (23:34) was 154th overall, Zawistowski (24:10) 171st and La Marr (26:33) 209th. La Marr was competing in her first race.

Rounding out Eastern's contingent were **Jessica Przygocki (Sr./Bristol)** and **Lauren Coonan (Sr./Malverne, NY)**. Both were timed in 31:04 in their first races.

MARSHALL PACES EASTERN W-CROSS COUNTRY IN OPENER

Fourth-year participant second against Bridgewater State in season and home-openers

MANSFIELD, Conn. – **Jessie Marshall (Sr./Yantic)** was the top Eastern Connecticut State University women's cross country finisher for the first time in her career as the Warriors opened the 2006 season with a 23-32 loss to Bridgewater State College at Mansfield Hollow State Park.

Having now competing in all 21 career meets over four years, Marshall placed second overall in a field of 12 finishers over the 2.5 mile course. She was 45 seconds off the pace of Bridgewater State junior Nicole Mauro, who broke away early in the competition and ran to a time of 18:23.

Marshall's time of 19:08 easily put her into second place, but Bridgewater all but nailed down the win when red shirts took places 3-4-5 in the form of seniors Sarah Hopkins (19:23) and Jennifer Waupotic (20:04) and freshman Kerri Rooke (20:19).

Eastern placed its five scoring runners ahead of Bridgewater's first five, but the Bears' depth – which accounted for four of the top five spots – gave them the win.

Terry Frechette (So./Ledyard), Clara Juncadella (So./Guilford), Ashley Behrent (Sr./Colchester) and Amy Zawistowski (Sr./Manchester) – all returnees from a year ago -- finished within 53 seconds of each other in the 6-through-9 slots.

CURLEY LEADS EASTERN M-CROSS COUNTRY IN OPENER

Bridgewater State College captures top three spots in downing Warriors, 20-37

MANSFIELD, Conn. – **Michael Curley (Jr./Branford)** led the Eastern Connecticut State University men's cross country team at the finish for the first time in his career but Bridgewater State College's scoring runners took five of the top eight spots Saturday as the Bears spoiled the Warriors' season and home-opener Saturday morning at Mansfield Hollow State Park.

In a field of 17 competitors run over 3.6 miles, junior Avery Bouchard, sophomore Brian Stewart and senior Dan Blair of Bridgewater all broke 20 minutes in taking the 1-2-3 spots before Curley (20:00) and rookie John Loffredo (Fr./East Hampton) took the 4-5 spots three seconds apart. In his first collegiate race, Loffredo was timed in 20:03 over the challenging layout.

Bridgewater's five scoring runners finished among the top eight, with only Curley, Loffredo and **Nick Noheimer (So./Willimantic)** breaking up that group. In tenth place overall, Sean McLaughlin (So./Branford) was Eastern's fourth finisher, with **Jim Condren (So./Southington)** rounding out the Warriors' scoring five.

Curley, in his third season with the program, was last year's No. 2 runner behind departed David Earle. He was second only to Earle in all six races a year ago.
